GEOGRAPHIC FOCUS RESIDENCY

Open to nationals of Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Hungary, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia

The European Investment Bank (EIB) Institute is looking for TWO visual artists to take part in the geographic focus residency of the Artists Development Programme (ADP).

The ADP offers emerging European visual artists a 6-8 week-long residency in Luxembourg, mentored by a renowned artist. In 2020, the recipients will each be mentored by acclaimed Finnish artist <u>Jorma Puranen</u>.

Residency timeline:

Group visit to Jorma Puranen's studio before the residency – **Spring 2020** Start of the residency in Luxembourg – **Early May** Unveiling of works produced during the residency – **22-23 June** End of residency – **25 June**

Package includes:

Travel costs to and from Jorma Puranen's studio, before the residency, and to and from Luxembourg (one return ticket).

A living/working space and a EUR 100 daily allowance to cover subsistence and all or part of the production costs.

A contribution towards production of EUR 500 at the beginning of the residency and a success fee of EUR 1 000 at the end of the residency, provided a work has been created.

Upon completion of the residency, the EIB might consider acquiring an artwork produced on-site by each of the artists.
