

ARTISTS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME 2021

GEOGRAPHIC FOCUS RESIDENCY

Open to nationals of Croatia, Cyprus, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Malta, Poland and Romania

The European Investment Bank (EIB) Institute is looking for ONE visual artist to take part in the geographic focus residency of the Artists Development Programme (ADP).

The ADP offers emerging European visual artists a 6-8 week residency in Luxembourg, mentored in 2021 by acclaimed Finnish artist <u>Jorma Puranen</u>.

Residency timeline:

Visit to Jorma Puranen's studio before the residency – **Spring 2021**

Start of the residency in Luxembourg - Early May

Unveiling of works produced during the residency – End of June

End of residency - End of June

Eligibility criteria

Aged 35 or under at the time of application (born after 1 January 1986)

National of Croatia, Cyprus, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Malta, Poland and Romania

Fluent in English

Practical information:

Travel costs to and from Jorma Puranen's studio before the residency, and to and from Luxembourg (one return ticket) will be covered.

A living/working space and a €100 daily allowance to cover living costs and all or part of the production costs.

A contribution towards production of €500 at the beginning of the residency and a success fee of €1 000 at the end of the residency, provided a work has been created.

Upon completion of the residency, the EIB may consider acquiring an artwork produced on-site by the artist.
